Chino Valley Unified School District
utilized the Advanced Rooftop Control
(ARC) pilot to upgrade their schools'
HVAC systems with better equipment and
controls.

Three energy-saving projects resulted in:

\$71,270 in rebates.

460,454 kWh in energy savings.

Reduced energy generation equivalent to 4.9 million pounds of carbon eliminated.

Carbon offset equivalent to 4,847 trees planted.

Reduced energy generation equivalent to 1.2 million gallons of water saved.
